When Anson was 18 years of age, he journeyed to Vincennes, IN
and then on to Merom, Sullivan County, IN to join other
members of his family. He resided in Sullivan Co. until
1850 when he moved to Vigo County. C.C. Oakey in his book
Greater Terre Haute, Vigo County states that Anson Clark
"was a member of the Christian Church, was both a Whig and
Republican in his political affiliations and was a soldier
of the War of 1812."* He is listed in the following Census
Records: 1830, 1840 and 1850, Sullivan Co., IN; 1860 and
1870, Vigo County, IN.
