

- (1) Jane, born August 21, 1761. Married to Bath County, Kentucky.
- (2) Thomas, born August 11, 1766. Died December 23, 1767.
- (3) Margaret, born October 23, 1767. (Married John Chambers in 1786 and moved to Kentucky.)
- (4) Thomas, born December 11, 1771. (See third generation)
- (5) Marthe, born April 1, 1773. (Married Kenneth A. Newton September 6, 1791 and moved to Montgomery County, Kentucky.)
- (6) Rebecca, born 1775. (Died young, unmarried).
- (7) Rachel, born August 3, 1777. (Married William Morgan in Clark County, Kentucky March 1, 1796 and lived in Henry County,

Margaret Black Feamster died in 1784 and William Feamster married Susanna Bratton. She died in 1786 without issue. He then on March 1, 1787 married a third wife, Mary Fulton. Their children were:

- (8) John, born in December 1787. (Married Mary Johnson January 27, 1825. No issue.)
- (9) George Washington, born September 19, 1789. (Married Nancy Bratton. No issue). Second marriage to a widow, Mary Cary, nee Arbuckle. One son, John A. All of his family moved to Frankfort, Kentucky.
- (10) Elizabeth, (born March 1791, married Captain Samuel Kincaid December 31, 1819. A daughter married William W. Woodson, step-brother of General Stonewall Jackson).
- (11) Sarah, born December 6, 1792 (Married Samuel Dickson April 3, 1818.)
- (12) Susanna, born in March 1794. (Married Robert Bratton March 13, 1823).
- (13) Samuel, born in September 20, 1797. (No other record, must have died as an infant.)
- (14) William, born November 13, 1799. (Married Mary Tyree. Four sons and daughters remained in Greenbrier and left many descendants.)
- (15) Alexander, born in September, 1801.

William, Senior died November 8, 1801. Alexander died January 11, 1802. Mary Fulton was said to have been recaptured from the Indians and that she did not know her true name.
