returned from captivity in June or July 1863 dis-
abled as stated, but he does not remember
for what reason disabled, and that thereafter
he was not fit for Active Duty March, if
Army of the time, and that when the Command
was prepared for the "March to the Sea" in
October 1864. (November) Surgt. Fenton
was sent to the war with this Considered
unfit for the expedition, and was placed
by Affairs in charge of the Brigade
Squad sent back.
