Any woman is eligible for membership in the National Society of the D of the American Revolution who is not less than eighteen years of age, and descended from a man or woman who, with unfailing loyalty to the American Independence, served as a sailor, or as a soldier or civil officer in the several Colonies or States, or in the United Colonies or States, or as a patriot, or rendered material aid thereto; provided the applicant is acceptable to the Society.

Official proof of service must be furnished with the application; also references to authorities quoted, to show line of descent. *Where reference is made to published or inaccessible records of service, the applicant must file the official copy*

### ANCESTOR'S SERVICES

My ancestor's services in assisting in the establishment of American Independence during the War of the Revolution were as follows:

Aldert Plough or Pleu enlisted in March 1781 at Westbrooks Fort on the Delaware River and served six months in Capt. Westbrooks' Rosekrantz Regt. He was discharged October 1781.

In August 1852, Aldert Plough <sup>(as set)</sup> applied for a pension on the above service. He died two months after the application for the pension was filed.

Aldert Plough's name is on the N. A. R. W. Tablet in the Sullivan County (Ind.) Courthouse which was erected in 1928.
