

According to page 272, history of the John Villiers family, Elizabeth (child no. 2) m. Robert Cree. Child no. 11, Priscilla Villiers m. George Haver. George Haver Jr. was born 1779, son of George Haver a native of New Jersey and came to the Tenmile where he bought a tract of land called "Misfortune," which had been warranted to Samuel Stroud. Patented on April 30, 1801 by George Haver Sr. this land remains in the hands of his descendants to this date. George Haver's wife was Elizabeth _____. George Haver, Jr. & Priscilla Villiers Haver, aunt and uncle of ELEANOR CREE IRONS had the following children who would have been Eleanor's cousins.

From the family of Robert Cree, Jr. and Elizabeth Villiers, child no. 1 was Ann Cree, sister of Elenor Cree Irons. Ann, b. Nov. 13, 1788 m. (date unknown at present) to Isaac Haver, a brother of George above. They were married in Greene Co., Pa. and came to Tuscarawas Co., Ohio about 1830, Rush Twp.

Children of Isaac Haver and Ann Cree Haver (sister & brother-in-law of Elenor Irons) according to Isaac's will probated in Tuscarawas Co.

Jane Haver and her dau. Margaret Ann, Minerva, Betsy, George, Robert, Mary, William, Isaac, James, Jacob and Rebecca.
