In the name of the Benevolent Father of all I John Wilson of the County of Sullivan and State of Indiana, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and making void, all former Wills by me at any time heretofore made first I direct that my body be decently Interred and that my funeral be Conducted in a manner corresponding with my Estate and Situation in life, and as to such worldly Estate as it has pleased God to entrust me with, I dispose of the same in the following Manner to wit, I direct that first all my just debts and funeral Expenses be paid as soon after my decease as possible, but of the first Money that shall come into the hands of my Executor from any portion of my Estate Real or personal. I hereby will and bequeath to my beloved Wife permelia Jane Wilson and her heirs that she has by me, they being my Children, of my real Estate the north East quarter of the South west quarter, of Section nine in Township six North of Range eight West containing forty acres and also my undivided Interest in the west half of the south west quarter of the East fractional quarter Section seventeen in Township six north of Range eight west containing Seventy eight acres and eighty seven hundredths of an acre which Interest came to me by the Death of John Wilson my son who died without heirs, and of my personal Estate I also will and bequeath to my said Wife and to her Children by me, two horses two Cows my Wagon the hind bearing for the horses to the wagon one Plough the horses bows and Plough to be chosen by her my said Wife after my decease also ten head of Sheep and twenty head of my Stock pigs also all of my house hold & Kitchen furniture of every description whatever. I hereby will to my beloved son William Wilson my Young man horse, I have heretofore advanced to my beloved Children their full shares of my Estate both real and personal, to wit to my son Berry Wilson his share, to Emanuel Wilson my son his share, to Adam Wilson
